

Welcome to Harwich International Port. This leaflet is your guide to the port, the routes you may need to follow and the rules in place to keep you and other port users safe during your visit.

On arrival at the port you will be directed to parking next to the Operations Centre, here you will check in and receive information about your ferry crossing, collection or delivery.

The Road Traffic Act, or Highway Code, applies in all areas of the port. The speed limit across the port is 20mph, Port Security will carry out spot checks. The speed limit will differ on vessel car decks.

Harwich International Port is compliant with ISPS and AEO regulations. You and your vehicle may be subject to a search by Port Security.

Harwich International will not tolerate physical or verbal abuse towards Port Staff.

Alcohol must not be consumed on the premises.

Always follow instructions from Port Staff or officials.

- No overtaking.
- Do not use your mobile phone while driving.
- No speeding.
- No alcohol to be consumed on the port.
- No weapons.
- You must not carry unauthorised passengers or pets in your vehicle.
- No stopping in hatched areas or on railway tracks.
- No photography.
- Always follow the green preferred walking routes when you leave your vehicle.
- Always wear Hi-Viz clothing.
- Always observe road markings and signs, give way to port plant.
- Do not approach hazardous cargo if a leak is suspected.
- Meal or rest breaks must be taken in the parking area.
